### HUNTER SAFETY PROGRAM

The St. Clair Shores Police Department and the Shorewood Kiwanis Club will co-sponsor the Michigan Department of Natural Resources 'Hunter Safety Program.' This training is mandatory for anyone born after January 01, 1960 wishing to purchase a Michigan Hunting License. It is also mandatory for anyone who intends to hunt in another state or Canada. Priority will be given to persons attending this class who attain the age of twelve (12) years by September 30, 2018.

This program will be conducted on the following dates and times and will be held in the City Hall Council Chambers, located at 27600 Jefferson in the City of St. Clair Shores:

**Saturday, September 8, 2018 – 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**

**(Registration begins @ 7:30-8:00am)**

**Class begins promptly at 8:00am**

**Sunday, September 9, 2018 – 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**

**Attendance on both days is Mandatory to complete this program.**

**\*\*Pre-Registration is Required.** Registration forms can be obtained beginning Monday, August 20, 2018 at 8am at the front desk of the St. Clair Shores Police Department, 27665 Jefferson Ave, St. Clair Shores, 48081. The class is limited to the first 100 registrants.

Students should dress for the weather on both days as the sessions consist of indoor and outdoor exercises. Students should also bring a 'bag lunch' both days.

Parents are encouraged to attend both classes with their children, although parental attendance is not required unless your child is under 10 yrs old.
